YOU LIKE TO CREATE THINGS – PRETTY THINGS, INTERESTING THINGS, THINGS YOU CAN TOUCH AND FEEL, THINGS YOU WANT TO SHARE WITH THE WORLD – AND IT WOULD NICE TO BE PAID AS WELL!

YOU CAN EASILY SELL YOUR CREATIONS ONLINE. THIS LIST IS A SIMPLE STARTING POINT. YOU CAN UPGRADE ANY PART OF THIS LATER, WHEN YOUR BUSINESS IS OFF THE GROUND. THE PRIMARY THINGS TO FOCUS ON FIRST ARE PUTTING YOUR ITEMS OUT THERE, AND GETTING PAID FOR THE WORK.

THE CHECKLIST

- o Set up a way to get paid. PayPal is one of the easiest places to start.
- o Take pictures of the works you want to sell
- o Set prices for the works you want to sell.
- o Investigate shipping costs as the US Postal Service, UPS or Fed Ex
- o Set up an online store

 - >> Ebay
 - >> Facebook
- o If you want to sell duplicated items of one work - think art on coffee mugs, t-shirts and tote bags:
 - >> TeeSpring
 - >> Shopify
- o Let your friends and family know about the store
 - >> Email

 - >> Instagram
- o Get Paid
- o Fill the orders and ship the items (if selling original pieces)
